

Rosemary Vaughn is the author of *Love on the Misty Isles*, her debut novel about three very different women who meet with unexpected love on Canada's remote islands of Haida Gwaii.

Vaughn was born and raised in Canada and lived on Haida Gwaii, formerly the Queen Charlotte Islands, for two years. In the 1970s she immigrated with her husband and two children to the United States, where she lived in Devil's Lake, North Dakota for 37 years. With a PhD in teaching and learning, she was a professor of teacher education at the University of North Dakota for many years.

Vaughn has held a lifelong passion for creativity, which she feeds not only with her writing but with community skits and puppet shows, as well as personal poetry and essays. In retirement her passion for writing has bloomed, giving rise to the award-winning *Love on the Misty Isles*.

Today, Vaughn spends her summers among the pines of Minnesota and her winters in palm-studded Florida, earning her the title of the Palm to Pine Writer.
